

Privacy Notice – Website

1. Introduction

This privacy notice will help you to understand what personal data Quitie Limited (company number SC309640) having its registered office at Glenugie Engineering Works, Peterhead, Aberdeenshire AB42 0YX collects about you, how we use this personal data, and what rights you have regarding your personal data when you use our website.

It is important that you read this notice, together with any other privacy notice that is provided to you on specific occasions when we are collecting or processing your personal data, so that you are aware of how and why we are using it.

This website is not intended for children and we do not knowingly collect data relating to children.

This privacy notice is issued on behalf of the Quitie Limited so when we mention "Quitie Limited", "we", "us" or "our" in this privacy notice, we are referring to Quitie Limited processing your data.

This website may include links to third-party websites, plug-ins and applications. Clicking on those links or enabling those connections may allow third parties to collect or share data about you. We do not control these third-party websites and are not responsible for their privacy statements. When you leave our website, we encourage you to read the privacy notice of every website you visit.

2. What information will we collect?

When someone visits our website we use a third party service, Google Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behavior patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way which does not identify anyone. We may also collect personally identifiable information from you when you complete a 'contact us' or other submission form on our website. This may include your personal contact details such as names, addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses, employer and job title.

3. How your data is used

We will only use your personal details when the law allows us to. Most commonly, we will use your personal data in the following circumstances:

- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interest such as corresponding with you regarding our services; and
- To allow us to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations.

We strive to provide you with choices regarding certain personal data uses, particularly around marketing and advertising.

We may use your data to form a view on what we think you may want or need, or what may be of interest to you. This is how we decide which products, services and offers may be relevant for you (we call this marketing).

You will receive marketing communications from us if you have requested information from us or purchased goods or services from us and, in each case, you have not opted out of receiving that marketing.

4. Use of cookies

We use "cookieconsent_status" to track whether you have accepted the cookie policy or not when you first visit the website, it will then time out after a year. Through our use of Google Analytics we also use the following cookies:

_gat	1 minute	Used to throttle request rate. If Google Analytics is deployed via Google Tag Manager, this cookie will be named _dc_gtm_<property-id>.

5. If you do not provide your personal data

If you do not provide all of the requested personal data then we may not be able to fulfill all or part of what you have instructed us to do.

6. How long we keep your personal data

Your personal data will be retained for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which we collected and to fulfil our legal, financial, accounting or reporting requirements.

7. Changes to this privacy notice

We reserve the right to update this privacy notice at any time and we will provide you with a new privacy notice when we make any substantial changes. We will also notify you in other ways from time to time about the processing of your personal data.

8. Your Rights

You have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- you have the right to request access to your data;
- you have the right to correct your data if it is incorrect;
- you have the right to obtain from the controller the erasure of your data;
- you have the right to object to your data being processed.
